GENERAL INFORMATION

Acajatuba road is located on the way to Manacapuru City, in the Amazon State. It is 68 miles from Manaus.

TESTIMONIAL/EVANGELISM

This well was drilled on the land of the Monte Sinai Presbyterian Church, which is a daughter church of the Central Presbyterian Church of Manaus. It was built to help their mission endeavor in the region. This is not a place by the river. It is located in the very middle of the jungle. The road is not paved and derives from the main road that comes from Manaus to the City of Manacapuru. The branch is 8 km long and leads to the Acajatuba village. On the way, development is sparse.

This is the second well in the region. The first well was completed on the Catholic Church land. There is a polarization between Catholics and Protestants that is present in this region.

Mr. Atlas Carvalho is the main leader from the Central Presbyterian Church of Manaus. Mr. Valdino Souza is the local lead. This church has existed for over 20 years and has an attendance of 17 people. Progress happens slowly. Sometimes the people face opposition from the Catholic Church.

Poverty and alcoholism are the main social problems of the region. The church is implementing small groups as an evangelism strategy to reach the local unsaved people.

HYGIENE TEACHING

Villagers were shown how to operate well, keep well clean, and safety guidelines. Also, we discussed how important it is to keep your hands clean by using the clean water. We distributed measuring spoons, which have an inexpensive treatment for diarrhea printed in Portuguese on them.
