### GENERAL INFORMATION

Gorethe is a village located by the Curua River, a tributary of the Amazon River, in the Para State, 349 miles from Manaus.

### TESTIMONIAL/EVANGELISM

This well was drilled on the property of the local public school. Before we drilled this well, the only way to get water was from rain or from a water tank truck. As this location has electric power, they village decided not to use a hand pump that we furnished because they plan to purchase a submersible electric pump. This well will serve over 1500 people. The village of Gorethe is covered by missionaries from the Emmanuel Baptist Church located in Curua City.

### HYGIENE TEACHING

Villagers were shown how to operate the well, keep well clean, and safety guidelines. Also, we discussed how important it is to keep your hands clean by using the clean water. We distributed measuring spoons, which have an inexpensive treatment for diarrhea printed in Portuguese on them.
